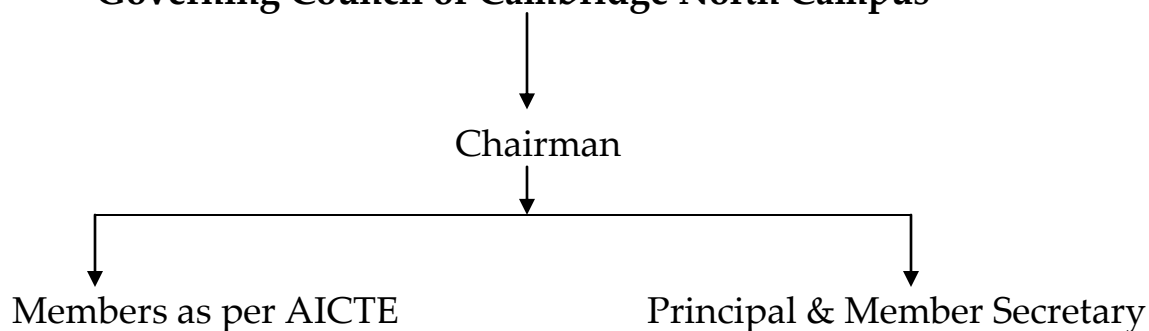

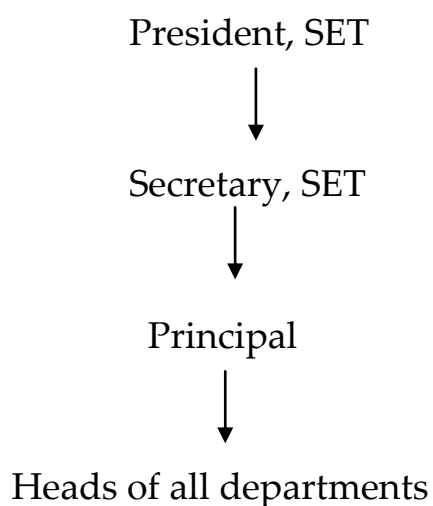

Time schedule for payment of fee for the entire programme

One month without fine at the beginning of every odd semester, i.e. up to 31st August of each year.

No. of Fee Waivers granted with amount and name of students:

5% of sanctioned intake which amounts to 6 students in each of CSE, ECE and ME branches get Tuition Fee Waiver as per AICTE norms and these students are selected by Karnataka CET authority.

VIII ADMISSION PROCEDURE

45% of students are admitted through CET and 30% students are admitted based on Common Entrance Test conducted by COMED-K and 25% of students are admitted under management quota.

IX CRITERIA AND WEIGHTAGES FOR ADMISSION

CET students are admitted based on reservation policy of Government of Karnataka. SC/ST and other backward community candidates are admitted as per rules and regulations of Government of Karnataka with minimum of 40% marks in the qualifying exam and based on rank of CET.

Display of marks scored in Test etc., and in aggregate for all candidates who were admitted are not indicated since admissions were done by the state based on CET and COMED-K tests.
